



The vineyards of the Auxerrois

Burgundy at the gates of Paris

When you find Chardonnay and Pinot Noir rubbing shoulders with snails and gougères....there's no doubt about it, you're in Burgundy!
Discover the art of fine living in true Auxerrois style. With a world-renowned, centuries-old wine-growing heritage and an equally rich gastronomic tradition...
Experience everything about our wonderful region.

Thanks to its waterways the vineyards of the Auxerrois region has for centuries supplied its finest wines, via Paris, to the capital cities of Europe.

Archaeological excavations at Escoives-Sainte-Camille, just a few kilometres from Auxerre, revealed a bas-relief showing a bunch of grapes dating from the 2nd century A.D.: this discovery indicates that the vineyards around Auxerre are the oldest known in the region.

The cradle of a large number of appellations, the vineyards are spread throughout a dozen villages which have kept their traditional wine-grower's architecture: Irancy, Saint-Bris-le-Vineux, Chitry, Coulanges-la-Vineuse, and Vincelles (which means "Wine Cellar").

The typical Burgundy cépages (grape varieties) are cultivated here: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Aligoté, Gamay, César...It is at Saint-Bris, astonishingly, that the Sauvignon grape produces a very aromatic white wine.

The OenoBus: on the trail of the vineyards of the Auxerrois

Discover the Auxerrois vineyards with the OenoBus, a free shuttle which runs every Tuesday in season. The OenoBus serves 6 typical wine villages: Escoives, Coulanges-la-Vineuse, Irancy, Chitry, Saint-Bris-le-Vineux, and the hamlet of Bailly.

Get off the bus at the village that makes you want to continue your exploration on foot, or just stay on board and discover the vineyards from the bus.

Wine and Gastronomy

- **January 27th and 28th, 2019:** Saint Vincent Tournante de Bourgogne in Vézelay. Saint Vincent, patron saint of winemakers, is celebrated every year in the winemaking villages. The village is decorated, mass is celebrated in his honour, Saint-Vincent processes through the streets as theatrical folklore events follow one after the other and, of course, wine tastings are available all day long.

**Grape juice which has not yet fully fermented. Sweet and often sparkling, it must be drunk within three or four days of bottling. For that reason it is not transported and can only be drunk in the region in which it is made. Try it while you are here!*



FLEURS DE VIGNE

The great wine festival of Chablis and the Grand Auxerrois

Every two years Fleurs de Vigne takes over the banks of the Yonne in Auxerre for a day of discovery of the vineyards of Chablis and Grand Auxerrois.

Winegrowers and merchants are there to let you taste their wines from the dozen appellations available in the area of the Yonne, but also to give you an insight into what they do, their passion and their know-how. While waiting for the next Fleurs de Vigne in May 2020 why not come to the Fleurs de Vigne Villages on May 18 and 19, 2019. It is an event in the heart of the villages and will give you the opportunity to discover the wine villages of the region and to meet the winemakers themselves.

CLOS DE LA CHAINETTE : VINES IN THE HEART OF THE TOWN



Once belonging to the Benedictine monks of the Abbey St Germain, the 4,15 hectares (10 acres) of the Clos de la Chainette is the only vineyard still producing in the town of Auxerre. It is also one of the oldest known domains in France and dates from the VII century. In the wake of the phylloxera crisis, which destroyed an extensive part of the wine production in Auxerre at the end of the 19th Century, le Clos-de-la-Chainette became the property of the Psychiatric Hospital of the Yonne and remains within its walls.

Classified as an AOC Bourgogne, the wines of le Clos-de-la-chainette preserve an ancient heritage. The domaine produces two types of wine: a white Burgundy and a red Burgundy.

THE CELLARS OF BAILLY LAPIERRE

A genuine pearl of the Auxerre region, the hamlet of Baily is located in the village of Saint-Bris-le-Vineux and is the birthplace of the AOC Crémant de Bourgogne. Baily Lapierre produce their sparkling wines in a unique setting: in a subterranean stone quarry, which provides unique natural conditions.

A rich gastronomy, synonymous with sharing and good times to the delight of the taste buds.

Genuine emblem of the region, the snail of Burgundy is THE speciality par excellence! In its shell with parsley and butter or cooked in another way: the snail captivates everyone! Discover the Helix snail farm at Gurgy, or La Maison Billot at Bassou, just a few kilometres from Auxerre where you can purchase their products.

Another major example: the truffle from Burgundy, genuine black diamond of gastronomy with its unique flavour! The Borvo smoked salmon: an institution in Burgundy! Not forgetting parsleyed ham in aspic, small pickled dills, blackcurrant liqueur, the famous Burgundian Gougères, which delight everyone at aperitif time, ham chablisienne, poached eggs in red wine sauce, Beef Bourguignon... and our many local cheeses like Epoisses, Soumaintrain or fresh goat's cheese.

For those with a sweet tooth, don't miss out on the honeyed spiced bread and even closer to home, the many varieties of cherries produced in the area.

LA GOUGÈRE: QUEEN OF THE APERITIF

The gougère is an unmissable delight of Burgundian gastronomy. Made with savoury choux pastry and cheese, it is the perfect accompaniment for aperitifs. Do not miss the October **Fête de la Gougère** in the different areas of Auxerre town centre, with demonstrations by artisan bakers and a competition for the best gougère (open to all).

CULTURAL DISCOVERY



The must see monuments of Auxerre

Auxerre, granted “Town of Art and History” status in 1995, has a conservation area covering 67 hectares. The Abbey, the cathedral, the narrow streets lined with half-timbered houses... Discover the remarkable heritage of Auxerre and its surroundings and its fascinating history!



Culture from a different perspective:

Throughout the year the Tourist Office offers unique guided tours, on different themes or on particular neighborhoods: Auxerre land of vines, folk tales and legends of Auxerre, Auxerre in antiquity...



BISHOP SAINT-GERMAIN L'AUXERROIS

The most illustrious bishop of Auxerre was Saint Germain (Bishop of Auxerre from 418 AD until his death in 448 AD), a man of faith who was also an able politician. In Auxerre, he started the movement to build the monasteries that surround the town and that make up a “holy wall”.

He left his mark far beyond the town, notably the famous church of Saint Germain l'Auxerrois in the 1st arrondissement of Paris close to the Louvre, bears his name. There are numerous churches named after Saint Germain l'Auxerrois all over France. In Auxerre we have a real treasure of our national heritage that bears his name: the beautiful and magnificent Saint Germain Abbey.

SAINT GERMAIN ABBEY

This monastic complex, located outside the fortifications, was founded by Queen Clotilde in the 5th century. Necropolis of the bishops of Auxerre, the abbey was at the height of its fame in the ninth century when it housed the prestigious school of Auxerre, which was one of the centres of the Carolingian Renaissance. This monument is witness to sixteen centuries of the history of Auxerre. Although composite, it offers an architectural ensemble of great interest. Its Carolingian crypts of the 9th century, built around the tomb of Saint Germain (378 - 448) are decorated with murals remarkable for their condition and age given that they are the oldest in France.

The abbey church is Gothic in style. In its fore-nave and part of the nave, which were demolished in the nineteenth century, were found interesting remains such as sarcophagi dating from the sixth to the ninth century. The chapter room is from the 12th century, the cellar from the 14th century, the classical style cloister was rebuilt in the 17th century.

The 12th century tower of Saint Jean overlooks the buildings with its imposing spire of convex eight-sided stone.

THE CLOCK TOWER AND ITS ASTRONOMICAL CLOCK

The clock Tower was built in the 15th century on the basis of a tower from the old Gallo-Roman fortified city. First used as a prison (of earl), it was turned into a clock and belfry in 1483. A fire devastated the tower in 1825 but it was restored and largely rebuilt identically between 1891 and 1893 by the great French architect Paul Boeswillwald. Attached to the tower, a chamber hosts the clock's mechanism which works since 1483, made by the ingenious clockmaker Jean. The clock's distinctive features are the two hands: the first is a solar hand (goes round the clock within 24 hours) and the second is a lunar hand which is slow of 3 quarters compared to the other. However, both hands juxtapose at midday at new moon and at midnight at full moon. The clock of Auxerre indicates at once the time and the moon phases.

Next to the tower is the house of a bailiff made famous in a children's

nursery rhyme and sung in all the schools in France: Guillaume Roussel, better known as Cadet Roussel.

SAINT-ETIENNE CATHEDRAL

A masterpiece of Gothic art, Saint Etienne Cathedral has just one tower.

Its façade is worth a few minutes of your time to have a look at the various sculptures that depict the life of the time. The 15th and 16th century stained glass windows are also worthy of a close look. A final tour down to the crypt to look at the extremely rare painting of Christ on horseback, and to the Treasury, which holds a number of collection pieces, including The Deposition from the Cross by Luca Penni.

SAINT-PIERRE CHURCH AND THE WINEMAKER'S DISTRICT

This church combines the use of Gothic style, Renaissance style and Classic style. It displays on its façade the patron saints of the district's brotherhoods (butchers and wine-makers) for whom it was the parish. Saint-Pierre district was the winemakers' until the phylloxera crisis happen and destroy the vineyards of the region of Auxerre

SAINT-EUSÈBE CHURCH

Seen from the outside, the building presents an heterogeneous profile with a Romanesque bell, a 13th century Gothic nave, and a 16th century Renaissance choir. The interior holds a number of wonderful surprises for visitors: paintings that decorate the vaults, and a magnificent set of windows that light up the Renaissance Choir.

Cadet Roussel

His real name was Guillaume Joseph Roussel, and was called "Cadet" because he was the middle child of the family. Born in 1743 in the Jura region, he settled in Auxerre in 1763 as a domestic and a lackey, then became a bailiff's clerk. He then bought a position and became a bailiff himself.

Come the Revolution, Cadet Roussel became a Jacobin. One of his political enemies, the Chevalier Chenu du Souchet, composed the famous song to mock him. That song was adopted as a marching song by the soldiers of the Revolution in 1792.

IN THE STEPS OF CADET ROUSSEL


Follow in the footsteps of Cadet Roussel and discover the treasures in the historic centre of Auxerre.

The walking tour enables you to discover the city's treasures at your own pace, following the bronze arrows on the ground. This tour is suggested to enjoy freely the main monuments, and also to discover the picturesque streets, some unusual views and lively districts.

> You could admire the 67 curiosities that make up this tour, and read the historical explanations in this brochure available in 5 languages (French, English, German, Italian, Dutch).

And to keep the youngsters amused, discover Cadet'Chou: a fun walk guided by a series of puzzles.

SAINT-GERMAIN MUSEUM



Set in the heart of the Benedictine Saint-Germain Abbey, this museum of Art and History is made up of four rooms which recount the city's story on three levels from prehistoric times up to the middle ages. Visit the scriptorium, the old sacristy and the old dorms to discover all museum collections.

The two masterpieces in its collections are the Shroud of Saint Germain, an exceptional Byzantine fabric dating back to the year 1000 and the Cheval de Guerchy.

MARIE NOËL

Born in Auxerre in 1883, Marie Noël was one of the great poetesses of the 20th century, admired by Valéry, Montherlant, and Aragon. She was awarded the Grand Prize for Poetry by the Académie Française in 1962, and was even appointed an Officer of the Legion of Honour. At her death in 1967, she bequeathed her works to the Yonne Department Society for Historical and Natural Sciences, which manages and studies her work through several publications.

CULTURAL HERITAGE of the Auxerre Region



THE TOWER OF CHITRY LE FORT

On the borders of the Chablis and Auxerre regions, Chitry-le-Fort is a typical winegrowing village where you will find Saint -Valérien Church, flanked by its 13th century fortified tower and now a listed building from which Chitry-le-fort gets its name.



THE RENAISSANCE HOUSE IN COULANGES-LA-VINEUSE

In the streets of this wine producing village evidence to the richness of its history is everywhere. In particular you can admire the renaissance façade of the current library with its beautiful painted ceiling.


There are numerous classified historical monuments at: Appoigny, Bleigny-le-Carreau, Branches, Charbuy, Chevannes, Coulanges-la-Vineuse, Escamps, Escolives-Sainte-Camille, Gy l'Evêque, Irancy, Jussy, Lindry, Perrigny, Quenne, Saint-Bris-le-Vineux, Vaux, Villeneuve-Saint-Salves, Vincelles, Vincelottes...



THE RENAISSANCE GATEWAY AT SAINT- BRIS-LE -VINEUX

The 13th Century church os Saint-Prix-Saint-Cot is one of the most beautiful in the Department. It is the choir of the church that houses its finest treasure: a monumental mural painted in 1500 and representing the Tree of Jesse.

The Renaissance attached to this building is classed as an Historic Monument. The village delights in its pretty timber-framed houses.



THE SO CALLED "EIFFEL" BRIDGE IN MONÉTEAU

Until 1879, the village was split into two distinct parts by the River Yonne. Two fords at each end of the bend in the Yonne allowed people to cross from one bank to the other.

The first suspension bridge was built in 1853, but by 1905, the bridge's single carriageway was not enough to carry the traffic that used it. Moreover, the Municipal Council called for a final work of large width: the decision was taken to put up a wide - span metal construction. which was completed on 20th August 1913. The bridge is now a listed structure, and has become the town's emblem.



THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE AT ESCOLIVES-SAINTE-CAMILLE

On going since 1955, the excavations have yielded evidence of human occupation dating from the Neolithic to the Merovingian periods.

Here you will find Gallo-Romano sculptures from the 2nd Century, Gallo-Romano and Merovingian furniture, sarcophagi... There is also an exhibition of objects from daily life as well as rarer items.

THE CHARMS OF *a Country town*

BARELY OUT OF TOWN

The Auxerre region offers a wide range of options for walking and hiking. Take the pathways which criss-cross the region to discover a beautifully verdant countryside.

Take some fresh air, get away and enjoy the magnificent rolling landscapes around Auxerre... Rucksack on your back and map in pocket, go for a breath of fresh air in the heart of the Auxerre countryside.

ALONG THE CANAL DU NIVERNAIS

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE LEGENDARY SAINT-JACQUES DE COMPOSTELLE (The Pilgrims' Way)



Auxerre is an essential stop on the route of Saint Jacques de Compostelle before passing through Vézelay and its eternal hill. La Maison des Randonneurs (The Hiker's House), a lodge located in the heart of the city and headquarters of the association Yonne Compostelle, offers (whether you are pilgrims or not), low-cost accommodation where friendliness and sharing are the order of the day.

AT THE RHYTHM OF THE WATER

Crossed by the Yonne and the Nivernais Canal, the auxerrois is an ideal destination for river tourism and nautical activities: barge trips, boat rental, water skiing, canoeing, fishing ... LOOKING FOR ACTION

Well known for its football team, Auxerre has always had a sporting spirit. In the region there are numerous activities which offer for the sporty and non-sporty alike, the possibility to outdo themselves.



ABBE DESCHAMPS

Very often, when one says "Auxerre", that reminds tourists of the football club. This world-renowned club was part of League 1 for 30 years and is unique for being the only private national club, having been set up by a churchman:

Abbé (abbot) Deschamps. Born in 1868, he founded the Association de la Jeunesse Auxerroise in 1905, more commonly known as AJA and gave his name to the renowned football stadium Abbé Deschamps, where AJA regularly play.

From Log Floating to Tourism

Due to the shortage of wood in Paris, traders exploited the forests of the Morvan. Once cut, the wood was floated on the Yonne as far as Clamecy and assembled into large rafts and on to Paris. A project started under Henry IV (1589-1610), the digging of a channel between the Loire and the Yonne in order to exploit the forests of the Bazois wasn't completed until 1784.

In 1786 the channel was transformed into a navigable canal, which opened in 1853. Used for the transport of merchandise at the time, it is now used for pleasure boating.
