The Abbaye St Germain, with its 1600 years of history, the cathedral of St Etienne with its unique stained-glass windows, the timber-framed houses lining the cobbled streets. Concentrated Burgundy an hour and a half away from Paris.

***** AUXERRE THE BEAUTIFUL VÉZELAY THE ETERNAL



On the agenda:

- Guided tour of Abbaye St Germain in Auxerre, a veritable jewel of the heritage of the Auxerre region and the Cathédrale St Etienne, a masterpiece of Gothic art. Discover this cultural heritage and plunge into history.
- Lunch in Auxerre with a starter, main course and dessert.
- Guided tour of the village of Vézelay and the Sainte Madeleine basilica situated at the top of the eternal hill, a UNES-CO world heritage site.
- Wine tasting of Vézelay wines with a full explanation.

Availability: every day all year round except Sundays and bank holidays.

On the agenda:

- **Guided tour of Guédelon,** a medieval adventure in the 21st century where around 50 workers are building a medieval fort using techniques and materials from the Middle Ages.
- Lunch at St Fargeau with a starter, main course and dessert.
- Guided tour of the Château of Saint-Fargeau, an imposing red brick fortress, whose history dates back 10 centuries.
- Guided tour of Auxerre's Cathédrale St Etienne, a masterpiece of Gothic art and an exploration of the Clock quarter, the second protected site in Burgundy.

Availability: from April to October.

* ST-BRIS-LE-VINEUX, A WINEGROWING VILLAGE TYPICAL OF BURGUNDY



\Im On the agenda:

- Explore this **typical winegrowing village** in the Auxerre region with its AOC St Bris. At the heart of the village you will discover numerous architectural treasures as well as a magnificent church, and plenty of anecdotes.
- Visit the winegrower's "domaine" and taste his wines with him, accompanied by gougères and savoury pastries.

Availability: Every day except Sundays and bank holidays.

* FROM AUXERRE TO CHABLIS BY BICYCLE A WEEKEND OF WHITE WINES AND ABBEYS



DAY 1 > Arrive in Auxerre

• Explore the old town with its Abbey St Germain and its 16 centuries of history. Spend the night in a magnificent 3 star hotel.

DAY 2 > Auxerre - Pontigny - Chablis

- Discover the the world's largest Cistercian Abbey in Pontigny.
- Continue towards **Chablis** and its world-famous Chardonnay !
- Tasting of the typically "mineral" Chardonnay. Stay the night in a **4 star hotel.**

DAY 3 > Chablis - St Bris - Auxerre

- Head off in the direction of **St-Bris-le-Vineux**, a magnificent winegrowing village and visit its splendid church.
- Following the visit, enjoy a **wine tasting** in an **historic wine cellar.**
- On the return journey stop off at the **Caves de Bailly** and discover **the cradle of Burgundian Crémant.**
